AN ACT

Amending the act of November 24, 1998 (P.L.882, No.111), entitled "An act providing for victims' rights; imposing penalties; establishing remedies; establishing the Office of Victim Advocate, the Bureau of Victims' Services, the Victims' Services Advisory Committee, the State Offender Supervision Fund and other funds; and making repeals," in administration, further providing for committee. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 321(b) and (c) of the act of November 24, 10 11 1998 (P.L.882, No.111), known as the Crime Victims Act, are 12 amended to read: Section 321. Committee. 13 * * * 14 15 (b) Membership.--The committee shall consist of [15] the 16 <u>following</u> members: 17 The Secretary of Aging or a designee. (1)18 (2) The Secretary of Corrections or a designee.

- 1 a designee. 2 The Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police or 3 a designee. (5) The victim advocate. 4 5 A district attorney appointed by the Governor. (6) 6 [Nine individuals appointed by the Governor. (7) 7 Members under this paragraph must represent direct victims, 8 Statewide victims' coalitions, prosecution-based 9 victim/witness programs and other victim service or victim 10 advocacy organizations, the courts, members of local government and other victims' organizations or organizations 11 involved in the coordination or delivery of services to 12 direct victims. At least one of the Governor's appointees 13 14 must be a representative of a victims' services agency 15 working directly with children.] The following individuals appointed by the Governor, each of whom shall be or represent 16 17 one of the following: 18 (i) A direct victim of crime representing female 19 victims. 20 (ii) A direct victim of crime representing male 21 victims.
