- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for department records for vehicle registration.

- 9 <u>(a) General rule.--</u>The department shall maintain suitable
- 10 records in a manner permitting identification of vehicles and
- 11 owners, including:
- 12 (1) All registrations and transfers of registrations

- denied and reasons for denial. Registrations and transfers

_3	(2) Application for a confidential registration shall be
4	made on a form furnished by the department.
.5	(3) Information concerning the identity of the

_7	only upon written request of the registrant or a law
8	enforcement agency.
_9	(4) Upon receipt of a request for information concerning
20	a confidential registration from a person or entity other
21	than the registrant or a law enforcement agency, the
22	department shall inform the requester that the identity of
23	the registrant is confidential and shall notify the
24	registrant of the identity of the requester.
25	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
