AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the 2 conduct of the executive and administrative work of the 3 Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the 4 administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers 5 thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 6 7 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain 8 administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 9 10 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the 12 salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 16 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse racing and 17 18 19 harness horse racing activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the disposition of funds from pari-mutuel 20 tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and 21 compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and 22 employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall 23 be determined," in administrative organization, further 24 providing for qualifications. 25
- 26 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 27 hereby enacts as follows:
- 28 Section 1. Section 217 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 29 No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended to

- 2 Section 217. Qualifications of employes. -- (a) All deputies,
- 3 directors, superintendents, and bureau or division chiefs, and
- 4 other employes, shall be persons especially qualified for their
- 5 positions by training and experience in the particular kind of
- 6 work which their official duties will require them to perform.
- 7 (b) An individual who applies for a position or promotion as
- 8 an employe in the executive, legislative or judicial branch of
- 9 State government must be a resident or former resident of this
- 10 <u>Commonwealth. A former resident of this Commonwealth must have</u>
- 11 relocated out of State for academic or employment purposes and
- 12 agree to establish Commonwealth residency within six months of
- 13 beginning employment or assuming the duties of the promotion.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
