## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of 2 controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics; 3 conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug, Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the 7 8 revocation or suspension of certain licenses and 9 registrations; and repealing an act," further providing for 10 administration of the act by requiring notification regarding 11 theft or loss of controlled substances. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 34 of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, 16 No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and 17 Cosmetic Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 18 Section 34. Administration of Act. -- \* \* \* 19 (c.1) If a controlled substance is stolen from or there is a 20 loss of controlled substances at a nursing home or assisted 21 living facility, pharmacy or hospital, the nursing home, assisted living facility, pharmacy or hospital shall promptly 22 provide notice of the theft or loss to appropriate local law 23

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
