## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in high schools, further providing 4 5 for courses of study. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. Section 1605 of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 11 amended by adding a subsection to read: 12 Section 1605. Courses of Study. \* \* \* 13 (d) Beginning with the 2019 2020 school year, the curriculum 14 for social studies under subsection (a) and courses enumerated 15 in that subsection shall contain a unit of study that includes 16 civics related subject matter of which naturalized citizens are 17 required to demonstrate a knowledge. The following shall apply: 18 (1) As a means to inform civics related curricula and

- 1 instruction, under any of the enumerated courses of study under
- 2 subsection (b), a test shall be administered which is identical
- 3 to the civics portion of the naturalization test used by the
- 4 <u>United States Citizenship and Immigration Services to survey a</u>
- 5 student's knowledge of the fundamentals of the history,
- 6 principles and form of the Government of the United States.
- 7 (2) The Department of Education shall promulgate rules and
- 8 <u>regulations to implement the provisions of this subsection,</u>
- 9 which shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- 10 (i) requiring that the aggregated results of the test for a
- 11 public, private or parochial school be reported to the
- 12 <u>Department of Education on an annual basis to help inform the</u>
- 13 <u>overall State approach to the social studies curriculum;</u>
- 14 <u>(ii) providing a written report to the Education Committee</u>
- 15 of the Senate and the Education Committee of the House of
- 16 Representatives within five years after the implementation of
- 17 this subsection to measure the impact of the test on the social
- 18 studies curriculum; and
- 19 (iii) developing a certificate of recognition for those
- 20 students scoring one hundred percent (100%) on the test.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 22 SECTION 1605. COURSES OF STUDY.--\* \* \*
- 23 (D) (1) BEGINNING IN THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH SCHOOL

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- 24 ENTITY SHALL:
- 25 (I) PROVIDE INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS RELATING TO THE CONTENT
- 26 OF THE ONE HUNDRED (100) QUESTION CIVICS TEST USED BY THE UNITED
- 27 STATES CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES AT LEAST ONCE DURING
- 28 GRADES SEVEN THROUGH TWELVE. THE INSTRUCTION MAY BE PROVIDED AS
- 29 A SEPARATE COURSE OR AS AN INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT WITHIN A COURSE
- 30 WHICH PROVIDES INSTRUCTION IN SOCIAL STUDIES UNDER SUBSECTION

- 1 (A).
- 2 (II) ADMINISTER A TEST TO STUDENTS THAT IS IDENTICAL TO THE
- 3 ONE HUNDRED (100) QUESTION CIVICS TEST USED BY THE UNITED STATES
- 4 <u>CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE</u>
- 5 COURSE OR INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT PROVIDED FOR UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH
- 6 (I). EACH SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL DETERMINE THE MANNER IN WHICH THE
- 7 TEST SHALL BE ADMINISTERED.
- 8 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 9 (I) NO LATER THAN THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR, POST ON ITS
- 10 PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE LINKS TO THE ONE HUNDRED
- 11 (100) QUESTION CIVICS TEST USED BY THE UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP
- 12 AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES AND ANY RELATED RESOURCES OFFERED BY
- 13 THE UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES. THE
- 14 DEPARTMENT SHALL POST ANY ADDITIONAL MATERIALS AND RESOURCES
- 15 THAT THE DEPARTMENT DEEMS USEFUL TO A SCHOOL ENTITY IN COMPLYING
- 16 WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 17 (II) CONDUCT AN ELECTRONIC SURVEY OF EACH SCHOOL ENTITY AT
- 18 THE CONCLUSION OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR AND AT THE
- 19 CONCLUSION OF EVERY OTHER SCHOOL YEAR THEREAFTER REQUESTING
- 20 INFORMATION REGARDING THE CIVICS TEST REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH
- 21 (1)(II). EACH SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL RESPOND TO THE SURVEY NO LATER
- 22 THAN NOVEMBER 30 FOLLOWING THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR WHICH THE SURVEY
- 23 IS CONDUCTED. THE SURVEY SHALL ONLY REQUEST THE FOLLOWING
- 24 INFORMATION REGARDING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING SCHOOL YEAR:
- 25 (A) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO TOOK THE CIVICS TEST.
- 26 (B) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO ATTAINED A PASSING
- 27 GRADE ON THE CIVICS TEST BY ANSWERING AT LEAST SIXTY PERCENT
- 28 (60%) OF THE TEST QUESTIONS CORRECTLY.
- 29 (C) THE GRADE LEVEL OR LEVELS IN WHICH THE CIVICS TEST WAS
- 30 ADMINISTERED.

- 1 (D) THE COURSE OR COURSES IN WHICH THE CIVICS TEST WAS
- 2 ADMINISTERED.
- 3 (III) MAKE THE DATA COLLECTED FROM THE SURVEYS CONDUCTED
- 4 UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) AVAILABLE ON ITS PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE
- 5 INTERNET WEBSITE.
- 6 (IV) DEVELOP A CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION FOR STUDENTS WHO
- 7 PASSED THE CIVICS TEST BY ANSWERING ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%)
- 8 OF THE TEST QUESTIONS CORRECTLY AND MAKE THE CERTIFICATE
- 9 AVAILABLE ON ITS PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE FOR USE BY
- 10 SCHOOL ENTITIES.
- 11 (3) A STUDENT WITH AN INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM SHALL
- 12 NOT BE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE CIVICS TEST REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH
- 13 (1)(II) IF THE PROVISIONS OF THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUALIZED
- 14 EDUCATION PROGRAM INDICATE OTHERWISE.
- 15 (4) AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND
- 16 PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS PARAGRAPH,
- 17 UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 18 "DEPARTMENT" SHALL MEAN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OF THE
- 19 COMMONWEALTH.
- "INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM" SHALL MEAN AN
- 21 INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM UNDER 22 PA. CODE CH. 14
- 22 (RELATING TO SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES AND PROGRAMS).
- 23 "SCHOOL ENTITY" SHALL MEAN A SCHOOL DISTRICT, AREA
- 24 VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOL, INTERMEDIATE UNIT, CHARTER SCHOOL,
- 25 CYBER CHARTER SCHOOL, REGIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL OR NONPUBLIC
- 26 SCHOOL.
- 27 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
