1 2 3 4	Amending the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128, No.43), entitled "An act authorizing the creation of agricultural areas," further providing for definitions and for purchase of agricultural conservation easements.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 3 of the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128,
8	No.43), known as the Agricultural Area Security Law, is amended
9	by adding a definition DEFINITIONS to read: <
10	Section 3. Definitions.
11	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
12	have the meanings given to them in this section, unless the
13	context clearly indicates otherwise:

15	"Agritourism." Activity carried out on land subject to a <
16	conservation easement under this act that provides entertainment
17	or education to the general public for the purpose of promoting

1	agricultural products or farming or rural lifestyles, regardless
2	of whether or not the general public pays to participate in the
3	activity including:
4	(1) interaction with farm or rural animals;
5	(2) farming or harvesting activities;
6	(3) tours, exhibitions or taste tests that promote the
7	farm or on farm produced products;
8	(4) bed and breakfast operations or similar lodging
9	accommodations that encourage engagement with farming or
10	harvesting activities or the farm's agricultural character or
11	<u>aesthetic nature;</u>
12	(5) equine training, teaching or recreational riding;
13	(6) games, rides and other entertainment activities
14	normally engaged in by farm families or rural communities;
15	and
16	(7) activities carried out in conjunction with seasonal
17	festivals to promote local agricultural products.
18	The term does not include rodeos, hunting, water skiing or
19	tubing, paintball and nonmotorized freestyle, mountain or off-
20	road bicycling.
21	"AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY." FARM-RELATED TOURISM OR FARM-RELATED <
22	ENTERTAINMENT ACTIVITY THAT:
23	(1) TAKES PLACE ON A FARM WHERE AGRICULTURAL,
24	HORTICULTURAL OR SILVICULTURAL CROPS ARE GROWN OR FARM
25	ANIMALS, RURAL ANIMALS OR FARMED FISH ARE RAISED; AND
26	(2) ALLOWS MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, WHETHER OR NOT
27	FOR A FEE, TO TOUR, EXPLORE, OBSERVE, LEARN ABOUT,
28	PARTICIPATE IN OR BE ENTERTAINED BY AN ASPECT OF AGRICULTURAL
29	PRODUCTION, HARVESTING, HUSBANDRY OR RURAL LIFESTYLE THAT
30	OCCURS ON THE FARM.

21	shall apply to	agricultural conservation easements executed	
22	after June 29,	1981.
