AN ACT

Amending the act of December 22, 2011 (P.L.586, No.127), entitled "An act providing for gas and hazardous liquids 2 pipelines and for powers and duties of the Pennsylvania 3 Public Utility Commission; and imposing civil penalties," making an editorial change and providing for duties of the 5 Department of Environmental Protection and of pipeline 6 7 operators. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The title of the act of December 22, 2011 11 (P.L.586, No.127), known as the Gas and Hazardous Liquids 12 Pipelines Act, is amended to read: 13 AN ACT Providing for gas and hazardous liquids pipelines and for powers 14 15 and duties of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission; 16 providing for duties of the Department of Environmental 17 Protection and of pipeline operators; and imposing civil 18 penalties. 19 Section 2. - 6 "Entity." Each of the following:
- 7 (1) The Department of Environmental Protection of the
- 8 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 9 <u>(2) A pipeline operator.</u>
- 10 Section 202. Notification.
- An entity shall provide notification to each resident,
- 12 municipality and other applicable party affected by the drilling
- 13 of a pipeline at least five days prior to the initiation of a
- 14 project.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
