- 1 Recognizing the week of May 14 through 20, 2017, as "National
 - Police Week" and designating May 8, 2017, as "Police
- Officers' Memorial Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, Since the beginning of law enforcement within this
- 5 Commonwealth, hundreds of police officers have made the ultimate
- 6 sacrifice while in the line of duty, including Police Officer
- 7 Scott Leslie Bashioum, Canonsburg Borough Police Department and
- 8 Trooper Landon E. Weaver, Pennsylvania State Police, who died in
- 9 2016; and

- 10 WHEREAS, Patrolman Edward A. Wehe, III, Delaware County
- 11 Courthouse and Park Police Department, died on November 5, 2013
- 12 of a heart attack shortly after removing protestors from
- 13 Delaware County Prison who did not have the proper permits; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Police Officer Walter J. DeWitt, III, Philadelphia
- 15 Police Department, died on June 5, 2015, during surgery from on-
- 16 the-job health complications; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Across the United States, the week of May 14 through
- 2 20, 2017, is being recognized as "National Police Week"; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The first "National Police Officers' Memorial Day"
- 4 was held on May 15, 1982, following a proclamation signed by
- 5 President John F. Kennedy on October 1, 1962; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The observance continues to be held annually in
- 7 memory of those police officers who have made the ultimate
- 8 sacrifice in the line of duty; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Senate honor the memory of the hundreds of
- 10 police officers who have given their lives in the line of duty
- 11 in this Commonwealth; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of May 14
- 13 through 20, 2017, as "National Police Week" and designating May
- 14 8, 2017, as "Police Officers' Memorial Day" in Pennsylvania.
