1 2	Designating April 24, 2017, as "Motorsports Day" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a long, rich history of motorsports
4	of all types; and
5	WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has benefited economically from
6	the longtime investments of a range of businesses that are
7	involved in the production and engineering of many motorsport
8	vehicles used in racing today; and
9	WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is one of two states with the highest
10	number of National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing
11	(NASCAR) fans, and approximately 20 chapters of the Official
12	NASCAR Members Clubs are located in this Commonwealth; and
13	WHEREAS, In terms of number of racetracks, this Commonwealth
14	ranks among the top five states in the country; and
15	WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is home to Pocono Raceway, the host of
16	one INDYCAR event and two Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series
17	events, and numerous smaller tracks located throughout this

1 Commonwealth which continue to contribute and hold events for

2 all types of motorsports; therefore be it
