A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of April 9 through 13, 2018, as "Work Zone Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, There were more than 100 fatalities and 9,300
- 4 crashes in Pennsylvania's work zones between 2012 and 2016; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Eighty-eight workers for the Department of
- 6 Transportation have lost their lives in the line of duty since
- 7 1970; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Forty-one workers of the Pennsylvania Turnpike
- 9 Commission have died while performing their duties; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has witnessed too many lives lost and
- 11 people severely injured, which also places a significant burden
- 12 on our communities and families; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Federal statistics show drivers to be the most
- 14 frequent fatality in work zone crashes, and the most common type
- 15 of work zone crashes are rear-end crashes; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Drivers in this Commonwealth can anticipate

- 1 traveling through a variety of work zones, particularly in
- 2 warmer weather, throughout our interconnected, interdependent
- 3 road system; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Drivers in Pennsylvania should obey all traffic laws
- 5 and best practices when entering and passing through work zones,
- 6 including, but not limited to, driving the posted speed limit,
- 7 avoiding distractions and paying close attention to signs and
- 8 workers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The General Assembly has taken action in the past to
- 10 reinforce our commitment to work zone safety and should continue
- 11 focusing on legislative priorities that bring our workers home
- 12 safely every day; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of April 9
- 14 through 13, 2018, as "Work Zone Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania;
- 15 and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the Senate urge all drivers in Pennsylvania to
- 17 be vigilant of the dangers of disobeying traffic laws in work
- 18 zones to improve the traffic safety conditions for our workers
- 19 throughout this Commonwealth.
