## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating June 26, 2018, as "Turkic Cultural Day" in
- 2 Pennsylvania and recognizing the valuable work of the Council
- of Turkic American Associations and the Turkish Cultural
- 4 Center of Pennsylvania.
- 5 WHEREAS, The Council of Turkic American Associations and the
- 6 Turkish Cultural Center of Pennsylvania are hosting their ninth
- 7 annual "Turkic Cultural Day"; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This observance showcases the rich mosaic of
- 9 different cultures, religions and ethnicities and educates the
- 10 public regarding the country of Turkey; and
- 11 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth proudly welcomes the Turkic-
- 12 American community to participate in "Turkic Cultural Day"
- 13 festivities; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Turkey, a secular democracy, has contributed to the
- 15 foreign policy of the United States in the Balkans, the Middle
- 16 East, Central Asia and the Caucasus; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The Council of Turkic American Associations is an
- 18 educational council that promotes Turkic-American culture and
- 19 heritage; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The Turkish Cultural Center of Pennsylvania
- 2 strengthens the cultural and educational ties among people from
- 3 diverse cultural backgrounds and furthers the cause of promoting
- 4 the Turkish heritage of tolerance and understanding; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Council of Turkic American Associations and the
- 6 Turkish Cultural Center of Pennsylvania serve a diverse Turkic-
- 7 American population in this Commonwealth with heritages from the
- 8 countries of Turkey, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan,
- 9 Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan and Tajikistan; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Americans of Turkic origin play a significant role
- 11 in the ethnic diversity of this Commonwealth by incorporating
- 12 their rich spiritual and cultural heritage and their dedication
- 13 to the responsibilities of good citizenship; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate June 26, 2018, as "Turkic
- 15 Cultural Day" in Pennsylvania and encourage all residents of
- 16 this Commonwealth to recognize the importance of this day; and
- 17 be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the efforts of the
- 19 Council of Turkic American Associations and the Turkish Cultural
- 20 Center of Pennsylvania in promoting mutual understanding,
- 21 respect and friendship between Turkic Americans and their
- 22 neighbors.
