- 1 Designating a bridge on that portion of Peg Run Road,
 - Pennsylvania Route 240, over the West Branch of the
- Susquehanna River, Susquehanna Township, Cambria County, as
 - the United States Army Sergeant Scott O. Henry Memorial

- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. United States Army Sergeant Scott O. Henry Memorial
- 9 Bridge.
- 10 (a) Designation. -- The bridge located on Peg Run Road,
- 11 Pennsylvania Route 240, over the West Branch of the Susquehanna
- 12 River, Susquehanna Township, Cambria County, is designated the
- 13 United States Army Sergeant Scott O. Henry Memorial Bridge- IN <
- 14 HONOR OF SCOTT O. HENRY WHO SERVED IN BOTH THE UNITED STATES
- 15 MARINE CORPS AND THE UNITED STATES ARMY. SCOTT O. HENRY WAS
- 16 KILLED IN ACTION IN VIETNAM AT THE BATTLE OF IA DRANG WHILE
- 17 RESCUING AN INJURED SOLDIER FROM THE FIELD OF BATTLE.

- 1 (b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 2 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 3 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 4 Section 2. Effective date.
- 5 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
