## AN ACT

12	Section 1. The act of November 23, 2010 (P.L.1083, No.108),
13	known as the Covered Device Recycling Act, is amended by adding

15	<u>Section 511. Waiver.</u>
16	(a) General ruleThe department shall waive the provisions
17	of this act for consumers residing in a municipality, any part
18	of which is located more than five miles from the nearest
19	recycling facility participating in an approved plan under this
20	act to collect and process electronics for recycling.

- 1 (b) Expiration.--This section and all waivers granted under
- 2 this section shall expire 10 years from the effective date of
- 3 <u>this section.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
