1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16	Amending the act of July 10, 1987 (P.L.246, No.47), entitled "An act empowering the Department of Community and Economic Development to assist municipalities in avoiding financial distress; declare certain municipalities as financially distressed; providing for the restructuring of debt of financially distressed municipalities; limiting the ability of financially distressed municipalities to obtain government funding; authorizing municipalities to participate in Federal debt adjustment actions and bankruptcy actions under certain circumstances; authorizing certain taxes; and providing for the disincorporated service districts," in Early Intervention Program, further providing for definitions, for program objectives and for authorization; in municipal financial distress, further providing for limitation of status; and making an editorial change.

Section 102-A. Program objectives. 10

11 The [Early Intervention] Strategic Management Planning

12 Program established by this chapter provides a municipality with 13 a preemptive step for the purpose of seeking guidance and 14 assistance from the Commonwealth to develop long-term financial management, administrative, service delivery and economic 15 16 development strategies that the municipality can implement to avert a fiscal crisis and provide fiscal stability. The specific 17 18 objectives of the [Early Intervention] Strategic Management_ 19 <u>Planning</u> Program include the following and are meant to:

22 The [Early Intervention] Strategic Management Planning 23 Program is established to authorize the center to provide 24 quidance and assistance through grants to a municipality seeking 25 to ensure fiscal stability by developing and implementing long-26 term financial, managerial and economic development strategies. 27 Section 254.
