- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against the family,
- further providing for the offense of concealing death of
- 4 child.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 4303(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 9 adding a subsection to read:
- 10 § 4303. Concealing death of child.
- 11 (a) Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of a [misdemeanor
- 12 of the first degree | felony of the third degree if he or she as
- 13 a parent, individual residing in the same household as the child
- 14 or an individual responsible for the child's welfare endeavors
- 15 privately, either alone or by the procurement of others, to
- 16 conceal the death of [his or her] the child, so that it may not
- 17 come to light, whether it was born dead or alive or whether it
- 18 was murdered or not.

- 2 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "parent"
- 3 means a natural parent, stepparent, adoptive parent, quardian or
- 4 <u>an individual involved in an intimate relationship with the</u>
- 5 child's parent.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
