AN ACT

Providing for an inventory of State-owned assets and county owned assets for the development of mobile broadband services
 in unserved areas and underserved areas of this Commonwealth
 AND FOR THE STATEWIDE MOBILE RADIO AND MICROWAVE SYSTEM. <---

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Short title.

8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the State-owned

9 Assets and Mobile Broadband Services Act.

10 Section 2. Definitions.

11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

13 context clearly indicates otherwise:

14 "Department." The Department of General Services of the

15 Commonwealth.

16 "Fixed broadband services." An Internet connection provided

through a link to a stationary location at a data bit rate or
 connectivity speed defined by department policy.

3 "Mobile broadband services." An Internet connection provided through a link to locations that are not stationary at a data 4 bit rate or connectivity speed defined by department policy. 5 6 "Qualified provider." A provider of mobile broadband service 7 that has obtained all governmental approvals required for the 8 provision of mobile broadband service in the unserved area or underserved area in which it seeks to provide the service. 9 "Secretary." The Secretary of General Services of the 10

11 Commonwealth.

12 "Underserved area." An area within this Commonwealth that is 13 demonstrated to have limited access to fixed broadband services 14 or mobile broadband services.

"Unserved area." An area within this Commonwealth that is demonstrated to not have access to fixed broadband services or mobile broadband service.

18 Section 3. Inventory of State-owned assets.

19 Under the act of June 15, 1972 (P.L.395, No.117), entitled 20 "An act providing for an inventory of all Commonwealth real property, except highway rights-of-way to be prepared by the 21 Department of Property and Supplies, for its availability to the 22 23 public, for its updating, and for cooperation by all State 24 governmental agencies; and making an appropriation," and section 25 508(b) of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as 26 The Administrative Code of 1929, the department shall include in its inventories and surveys of real estate structures and assets 27 28 information on possible use of those assets for fixed broadband 29 services or mobile broadband services. The information shall be 30 used by the department or its designee when analyzing resources

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available in providing broadband services in underserved areas
 and unserved areas.

3 Section 3.1. Inventory of county-owned assets.

4 (a) Preparation of inventories.--A county may prepare and
5 periodically update an inventory of county-owned assets that are
6 available and may be used to provide broadband services in
7 underserved areas and unserved areas.

8 (b) Transmission to department.--A county inventory prepared 9 under subsection (a) may be transmitted to the department and 10 shall be included in the information used by the department 11 under section 3 when analyzing resources available to provide 12 broadband services in underserved areas and unserved areas. 13 Section 4. Lease or conveyance of State-owned assets.

14 (a) General rule.--Notwithstanding any provision of law to 15 the contrary and subject to the guidelines adopted by the 16 department under section 5, the department having responsibility for a State-owned asset in an unserved area or underserved area 17 18 may lease or convey a license or other interest in the asset to a qualified provider in order to permit the use of the asset by 19 20 the qualified provider in the deployment of mobile broadband service within the unserved area or underserved area or portion 21 of that unserved area or underserved area. 22

(b) Evidence of compliance.--The requirement under subsection (a) is subject to the qualified provider presenting to the department evidence of compliance with structural, permitting and other guidelines under section 5, which will be reviewed by the department or its designee.

28 Section 5. Departmental guidelines.

29 The department or its designee shall adopt guidelines for the 30 following:

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(1) Qualifications for broadband service providers.

2 (2) Negotiating and finalizing site occupancy3 agreements.

4 Section 6. Approvals.

5 The department or its designee shall identify an appropriate
6 timeline of no more than 30 90 days for approval of site
7 occupancy agreements.

8 SECTION 7. STATEWIDE MOBILE RADIO AND MICROWAVE SYSTEM. <--

9 (A) JURISDICTION.--THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE SHALL HAVE 10 JURISDICTION OVER THE STATEWIDE MOBILE RADIO AND MICROWAVE 11 SYSTEM DESCRIBED IN THE ACT OF DECEMBER 5, 1996 (P.L.921, 12 NO.148), KNOWN AS THE CAPITAL BUDGET PROJECT ITEMIZATION ACT FOR 13 1996-1997.

14 (B) ALLOCATION OF PROCEEDS.--PROCEEDS FROM THE LEASE OR 15 LICENSING OF A TOWER OR OTHER ASSET OF THE STATEWIDE MOBILE 16 RADIO AND MICROWAVE SYSTEM SHALL BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF 17 MAINTAINING AND IMPROVING THE SYSTEM.

18 Section 7 8. Applicability.

19ThisEXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SECTION 7, THIS act<--</th>20shall not apply to the Pennsylvania State Police and the21Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.

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22 Section 8 9. Effective date.

23 This act shall take effect immediately IN 180 DAYS. <--

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
