## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), entitled "An act relating to health care; prescribing the powers and duties of the Department of Health; establishing and providing the powers and duties of the State Health Coordinating Council, health systems agencies and Health Care Policy Board in the Department of Health, and State Health 5 6 Facility Hearing Board in the Department of Justice; 7 providing for certification of need of health care providers and prescribing penalties, " in general provisions, repeals 9 and effective date, providing for acute care mental health 10 bed registry and referrals. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. The act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by adding a 15 16 section to read: Section 901.1. Acute care mental health bed registry and 17 18 referrals. 19 (a) The department shall develop and administer an Internet 20 web-based acute care mental health bed registry to facilitate 21 the temporary hospitalization and treatment of individuals who

- 1 meet the criteria for inpatient examination and treatment under
- 2 Article II or III of the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.817, No.143),
- 3 known as the "Mental Health Procedures Act."
- 4 (b) The department shall make the bed registry accessible to
- 5 <u>health care professionals and their designees who are treating</u>
- 6 patients in need of mental health inpatient examination and
- 7 <u>treatment and to participating facilities.</u>
- 8 (c) The department shall design the bed registry to collect,
- 9 aggregate and display the information under subsection (d).
- 10 (d) The bed registry shall include all of the following
- 11 <u>information:</u>
- 12 <u>(1) General descriptive information for each</u>
- 13 participating facility, including contact information and the
- 14 <u>type of treatment and services available at each</u>
- 15 <u>participating facility.</u>
- 16 (2) Information on the number of acute care mental
- 17 health beds available at each participating facility, which
- information shall be updated every eight hours.
- 19 (3) For each available acute care mental health bed at a
- 20 participating facility, the type of patient that may be
- admitted.
- 22 <u>(4) The level of security provided at each participating</u>
- 23 <u>facility</u>.
- 24 (5) Any other information that may assist a health care
- 25 professional in identifying an appropriate acute care mental
- 26 <u>health bed for an individual in need of inpatient examination</u>
- 27 <u>and treatment.</u>
- 28 (e) The department shall design the bed registry to allow
- 29 <u>health care professionals and their designees to search the bed</u>
- 30 registry for an appropriate acute care mental health bed for an

- 1 <u>individual in need of inpatient examination or treatment.</u>
- 2 (f) To be eligible to access the bed registry, a facility
- 3 must:
- 4 (1) submit information specified under subsection (d) to
- 5 the department for inclusion in the bed registry; and
- 6 (2) permit the facility's contact information to be
- 7 monitored and accessed at any time in accordance with the
- 8 <u>department's regulations promulgated under subsection (h).</u>
- 9 (g) The department may contract with a third party to
- 10 <u>develop</u> and administer the bed registry.
- 11 (h) The department shall promulgate regulations necessary to
- 12 <u>implement this section</u>.
- (i) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 14 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 15 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 16 "Acute care mental health bed." A bed located at a mental
- 17 health facility that provides acute care mental health services.
- 18 <u>"Bed registry." The acute care mental health bed registry</u>
- 19 established under this section.
- 20 <u>"Facility." A mental health facility.</u>
- 21 "Health care professional." An individual licensed as a
- 22 physician, osteopath, physician assistant or certified
- 23 registered nurse practitioner.
- 24 <u>"Mental health facility." A distinct part of a general</u>
- 25 hospital licensed by the department under this act or a facility
- 26 that exclusively cares for the mentally ill and is licensed by
- 27 the Department of Human Services under the "Mental Health
- 28 Procedures Act" or Article X of the act of June 13, 1967
- 29 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the "Human Services Code," that
- 30 provides inpatient mental health examination and treatment. The

- 1 term shall not include the emergency department of a general
- 2 <u>hospital</u>.
- 3 "Participating facility." A facility that satisfies the
- 4 conditions under subsection (f).
- 5 Section 2. Within 10 days of the development of the bed
- 6 registry under section 901.1 of the act, the department shall
- 7 provide notice of the development of the bed registry to the
- 8 Legislative Reference Bureau, which shall publish notice in the
- 9 Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 11 (1) The following shall take effect immediately:
- 12 (i) This section.
- 13 (ii) The addition of section 901.1(h) of the act.
- 14 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect 60 days
- after the date of the publication of the notice under section
- 16 2 of this act.
