## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in vocational education, providing 5 for a workforce development program clearinghouse. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 11 section to read: 12 Section 1842.1. Workforce Development Program Clearinghouse. -- (a) No later than January 13 14 Department of Education shall, in consultation with the 15 Department of Labor and Industry, conduct an inventory to 16 determine the number and types of 17 offered at secondary and postsecondary institutions.

Department of Education may, in consultation with the Department

- 1 of Labor and Industry, compile a clearinghouse of model programs
- 2 <u>discovered during the inventory. The Department of Education THE\_</u><--
- 3 PENNSYLVANIA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD SHALL, WITH ASSISTANCE
- 4 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, CONDUCT A SURVEY TO DETERMINE
- 5 THE NUMBER AND TYPES OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS OFFERED
- 6 AT SECONDARY AND POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTIONS. THE PENNSYLVANIA
- 7 WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD MAY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE
- 8 <u>DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, COMPILE A CLEARINGHOUSE OF MODEL</u>
- 9 PROGRAMS DISCOVERED DURING THE SURVEY.
- 10 (B) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION and the Department of Labor
- 11 and Industry shall encourage the use of the model programs,
- 12 which may include prioritizing available grant funding for
- 13 <u>applicants seeking funds to establish workforce development</u>
- 14 programs that are modeled after the programs included in the
- 15 inventory SURVEY, by secondary career and technical education <--
- 16 programs, postsecondary programs and business and industry to:
- 17 (1) expand existing programs into areas of this Commonwealth
- 18 where there is a need; and
- 19 (2) foster business-education partnerships.
- 20 (b) The Department of Education (C) THE PENNSYLVANIA <--
- 21 WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD shall report its findings and
- 22 actions under subsection (a) THIS SECTION to the chairman and <--
- 23 minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate,
- 24 the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations
- 25 Committee of the House of Representatives, the chairman and
- 26 minority chairman of the Education Committee of the Senate and
- 27 the chairman and minority chairman of the Education Committee of
- 28 the House of Representatives, no later than <del>June 30, 2020</del> ONE <--
- 29 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
