- In addition to the provisions of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating
- 14 to open meetings), prior to entering into an agreement to sell
- 15 or lease a water or sewer system owned or operated by a
- 16 <u>municipal corporation or to sell or lease a water or sewer</u>
- 17 system currently operated by a municipal authority that would
- 18 require dissolution by the municipal corporation, the municipal
- 19 corporation shall hold at least 1 advertised public meeting, not
- 20 more than 60 days nor fewer than 7 days prior to entering into
- 21 the agreement with the potential purchaser or lessee, and shall
- 22 provide public notice of the meeting in all municipalities
- 23 <u>served by the water or sewer system. The potential purchaser or</u>
- 24 lessee shall attend the meeting.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
