- Amending the act of November 22, 2005 (P.L.407, No.74), entitled "An act establishing a program for breast and cervical cancer screening services for certain eligible women; and providing 3 for the powers and duties of the Department of Health," further providing for DEFINITIONS AND FOR Pennsylvania Breast <--5 and Cervical Cancer Early Screening DETECTION SCREENING 6 Program-; AND MAKING AN EDITORIAL CHANGE. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of November 22, 2005 <--11 (P.L.407, No.74), known as the Pennsylvania Breast and Cervical 12 Cancer Early Screening Act, is amended to read: 13 SECTION 1. THE TITLE OF THE ACT OF NOVEMBER 22, 2005 <--(P.L.407, NO.74), KNOWN AS THE PENNSYLVANIA BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER EARLY SCREENING ACT, IS AMENDED TO READ: 15 16 AN ACT
- 17 ESTABLISHING A PROGRAM FOR BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING

- 1 SERVICES FOR CERTAIN ELIGIBLE [WOMEN] <u>INDIVIDUALS</u>; AND
- 2 PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 3 HEALTH.
- 4 SECTION 2. THE DEFINITION OF "PROGRAM" IN SECTION 2 OF THE
- 5 ACT IS AMENDED TO READ:

- 7 THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS ACT SHALL
- 8 HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE

- 11 "PROGRAM." THE PENNSYLVANIA BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER EARLY
- 12 [SCREENING] <u>DETECTION</u> PROGRAM ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 3.

- 14 SECTION 3. SECTION 3 OF THE ACT IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 15 Section 3. Pennsylvania Breast and Cervical Cancer Early
- 16 [Screening] <u>DETECTION</u> Program established.
- 17 (a) Program established. -- There is hereby established within

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- 18 the Department of Health a program to be known as the
- 19 Pennsylvania Breast and Cervical Cancer Early [Screening]
- 20 <u>DETECTION</u> Program, which shall provide for the availability of
- 21 [annual] ROUTINE breast cancer and cervical cancer screening <--
- 22 services <u>ACCORDING TO RECOMMENDED SCHEDULES</u> for low-income <--
- 23 underinsured and uninsured [women] <u>INDIVIDUALS</u> who are [40] 30 <--
- 24 to [49] 65 64 years of age[.] FOR BREAST CANCER SCREENING AND 21 <--
- 25 TO 64 YEARS OF AGE FOR CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING.
- 26 (b) Screening services. -- The program shall be administered
- 27 by the department for [women] <u>INDIVIDUALS</u> who are eligible under <--
- 28 subsection (c) and shall be targeted towards [women] INDIVIDUALS <--
- 29 who are at high risk for breast and cervical cancer.
- 30 (c) Eligibility. -- To be eligible for the program, an

- 1 individual must meet all of the following requirements:
- 2 (1) Be [a woman] <u>AN INDIVIDUAL</u> who is $\frac{1}{40}$ to [49] $\frac{65}{40}$
- 3 <u>64</u> years of age[.] <u>FOR BREAST CANCER SCREENING AND 21 TO 64</u> <--
- 4 YEARS OF AGE FOR CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING.
- 5 (2) Have a family income that does not exceed 250% of the Federal poverty level.
- 7 (3) Have no health insurance coverage for screening
- 8 mammograms, clinical breast examinations, Pap tests and
- 9 pelvic examinations for [women] <u>INDIVIDUALS</u>.
- 10 Section 2 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days. <--
