AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), entitled "An 1 act relating to insurance; establishing an insurance department; and amending, revising, and consolidating the law 3 relating to the licensing, qualification, regulation, 5 examination, suspension, and dissolution of insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-6 insurance exchanges, and certain societies and orders, the 7 8 examination and regulation of fire insurance rating bureaus, and the licensing and regulation of insurance agents and 9 brokers; the service of legal process upon foreign insurance 10 companies, associations or exchanges; providing penalties, 11 and repealing existing laws," in preliminary provisions, 12 further providing for application of act. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Section 103(b)(2) of the act of May 17, 1921 17 (P.L.789, No.285), known as The Insurance Department Act of 18 1921, is amended to read: 19 Section 103. Application of Act. -- * * * 20 Nothing in this act shall apply to a religious publication, or its subscribers, that meet all of the following 21 22 criteria:

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
