Investigation of reports. * * * 9 10 Investigative actions. -- During the investigation, all of the following shall apply: 11 * * * 12 13 (5) The county agency shall have access to and shall 14 review each record relating to the child, including medical 15 records, records of drug and alcohol treatment, RECORDS OF 16 MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT and school records pursuant to the 17 cooperation required under sections 6340.1 (relating to exchange of information) and 6346 (relating to cooperation of 18
