2 (11) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing 3 from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all other 4 sources among:

6 for property tax relief and free or reduced (iv) 7 fare transit service for the elderly as provided in 8 section 311. For fiscal years beginning before July 1, 9 2014, no less than 27% of the total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be 10 11 dedicated to this subparagraph. For fiscal years 12 beginning after June 30, 2014, and ending June 30, 2019, 13 no less than 25% of the total revenues accruing from the 14 sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this subparagraph.
