AN ACT

1 Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled  
2 "An act providing for access to public information, for a  
3 designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency,  
4 local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for  
5 procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial  
6 review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing  
7 penalties; providing for reporting by State-related  
8 institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract  
9 information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in  
10 procedure, further providing for exceptions for public  
11 records.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. Section 708(b)(6)(i) and (ii) of the act of  
15 February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law,  
16 are amended to read:

17 Section 708. Exceptions for public records.

19 (b) Exceptions.--Except as provided in subsections (c) and  
20 (d), the following are exempt from access by a requester under  
21 this act:

1 (6) (i) [The following personal identification  
2 information:

3 (A) A record containing all or part of a  
4 person's Social Security number, driver's license  
5 number, personal financial information, home,  
6 cellular or personal telephone numbers, personal e-  
7 mail addresses, employee number or other confidential  
8 personal identification number.

9 (B) A spouse's name, marital status or  
10 beneficiary or dependent information.

11 (C) The home address of a law enforcement  
12 officer or judge.

13 (ii) Nothing in this paragraph shall preclude the  
14 release of] All personal information except for the name,  
15 position, salary, actual compensation or other payments  
16 or expenses, employment contract, employment-related  
17 contract or agreement and length of service of a public  
18 official or an agency employee.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
