AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), entitled "An act reforming the law on medical professional liability; 2 providing for patient safety and reporting; establishing the Patient Safety Authority and the Patient Safety Trust Fund; abrogating regulations; providing for medical professional 5 liability informed consent, damages, expert qualifications, 6 limitations of actions and medical records; establishing the 7 Interbranch Commission on Venue; providing for medical professional liability insurance; establishing the Medical 9 Care Availability and Reduction of Error Fund; providing for 10 medical professional liability claims; establishing the Joint 11 Underwriting Association; regulating medical professional 12 liability insurance; providing for medical licensure 13 regulation; providing for administration; imposing penalties; 14 and making repeals, " in medical professional liability, 15 providing for reporting of surveys and inspections. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1. The act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), known 20 as the Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare) 21 Act, is amended by adding a section to read: 22 Section 517. Reporting of surveys and inspections.

- 5 (b) Personal care home and assisted living residence
- 6 <u>inspections.--The Department of Human Services shall have</u>
- 7 <u>available for public inspection on its publicly accessible</u>
- 8 <u>Internet website reports of all inspections conducted of</u>
- 9 personal care homes or assisted living residences licensed under
- 10 the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human
- 11 Services Code.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
