AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 2 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 7 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in personal income tax, further providing for 10 classes of income. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 303(a)(1)(i) of the act of March 4, 1971 15 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended 16 to read: 17 Section 303. - 6 Pennsylvania as a member of the United States Public Health
- 7 <u>Service or the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration</u>
- 8 and income from the United States Government or the Commonwealth
- 9 of Pennsylvania for active State duty for emergency within or
- 10 outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including duty ordered
- 11 pursuant to 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 76 (relating to Emergency Management
- 12 Assistance Compact).
