## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for

definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for 3 suspension of operating privilege; in rules of the road in general, further providing for the offense of overtaking vehicle on the left; in special vehicles and pedestrians, further providing for penalty for violation of subchapter; 6 7 and, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the 8 offense of careless driving and for the offense of reckless driving. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 14 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read: § 102. Definitions. 15 16 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent provisions of this title which are applicable to specific 17 18 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when 19 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly 20 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

- 1 <u>"Vulnerable highway user." A pedestrian or a person on a</u>
- 2 <u>self-propelled transportation device</u>, an auxiliary-powered
- 3 transportation device, an animal, an animal-drawn vehicle or a
- 4 farm vehicle, and who is lawfully on a highway.

- 6 Section 2. Sections 1532(a) and (b)(1) and (5), 3303(a)(3),
- 7 3502 and 3714 of Title 75 are amended to read:
- 8 § 1532. Suspension of operating privilege.
- 9 (a) One-year suspension. -- The department shall suspend the
- 10 operating privilege of any driver for one year upon receiving a
- 11 certified record of the driver's conviction of or an
- 12 adjudication of delinquency based on any of the following
- 13 offenses:
- 14 (1) Any felony in the commission of which a court
- determines that a vehicle was essentially involved.
- 16 (3) Any violation of the following provisions:
- 17 <u>Section 3714(b.1) (relating to careless driving).</u>
- 18 Section 3735.1 (relating to aggravated assault by
- vehicle while driving under the influence).
- 20 Section 3742 (relating to accidents involving death
- or personal injury).
- 22 Section 3742.1 (relating to accidents involving death
- or personal injury while not properly licensed).
- Section 7111 (relating to dealing in titles and
- plates for stolen vehicles).
- Section 7121 (relating to false application for
- 27 certificate of title or registration).

- 1 (b) Suspension.--
- 2 (1) The department shall suspend the operating privilege
- 3 of any driver for six months upon receiving a certified
- 4 record of the driver's conviction of or an adjudication of
- 5 delinquency based on any offense under the following
- 6 provisions:
- 7 Section 3367 (relating to racing on highways).
- 8 Section 3714(b)[(relating to careless driving)] or
- 9 <u>(c.1)</u>.
- 10 Section 3734 (relating to driving without lights to
- 11 avoid identification or arrest).
- 12 Section 3736 (relating to reckless driving).
- 13 Section 3743 (relating to accidents involving damage
- 14 to attended vehicle or property).
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 (5) The department shall suspend the operating privilege
- of any driver for three months upon receiving a certified
- 18 record of the driver's conviction of or an adjudication of
- delinquency based on section 3714(c) or (c.2).

- 21 § 3303. Overtaking vehicle on the left.
- 22 (a) General rule. -- The following rules shall govern the
- 23 overtaking and passing of vehicles proceeding in the same
- 24 direction, subject to the limitations, exceptions and special
- 25 rules stated in this chapter:

- 27 (3) The driver of a motor vehicle overtaking a
- [pedalcycle] <u>vulnerable highway user</u> proceeding in the same
- direction shall pass to the left of the [pedalcycle]
- 30 <u>vulnerable highway user</u> within not less than four feet at a

- 1 careful and prudent reduced speed.

- 3 § 3502. Penalty for violation of subchapter.
- 4 Any person violating any provision of this subchapter is
- 5 guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be
- 6 sentenced to pay a fine of [\$10] \$25.
- 7 § 3714. Careless driving.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Any person who drives a vehicle in
- 9 careless disregard for the safety of persons or property is
- 10 guilty of careless driving, a summary offense.
- 11 (b) Unintentional death.--[If] Except as provided in
- 12 <u>subsection</u> (b.1), if the person who violates this section
- 13 unintentionally causes the death of another person as a result
- 14 of the violation, the person shall, upon conviction, be
- 15 sentenced to pay a fine of \$500.
- 16 (b.1) Death involving a vulnerable highway user.--If the
- 17 person who violates this section causes the death of a
- 18 <u>vulnerable highway user as a result of the violation, the person</u>
- 19 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more
- 20 than \$5,000.
- 21 (c) Serious bodily injury.--[If] Except as provided in
- 22 <u>subsection (c.1), if</u> the person who violates this section
- 23 unintentionally causes the serious bodily injury of another
- 24 person as a result of the violation, the person shall, upon
- 25 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$250.
- 26 (c.1) Serious bodily injury to a vulnerable highway user.--
- 27 If the person who violates this section causes the serious
- 28 bodily injury of a vulnerable highway user as a result of the
- 29 <u>violation</u>, the person shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
- 30 pay a fine of not more than \$2,500.

- 1 (c.2) Bodily injury to a vulnerable highway user.--If a
- 2 person who violates this section causes the bodily injury of a
- 3 <u>vulnerable highway user as a result of the violation, the person</u>
- 4 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more
- 5 than \$500.
- 6 Section 3. Section 3736(b) of Title 75 is amended and the
- 7 section is amended by adding subsections to read:
- 8 § 3736. Reckless driving.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (b) Penalty. -- [Any] Except as provided in subsections (c),
- 11 (d) and (e), any person who violates this section commits a
- 12 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 13 a fine of \$200.
- 14 (c) Death involving a vulnerable highway user. -- A person who
- 15 <u>violates this section and causes the death of a vulnerable</u>
- 16 <u>highway user as a result of the violation commits a misdemeanor</u>
- 17 of the first degree and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
- 18 pay a fine of not more than \$10,000.
- 19 (d) Serious bodily injury to a vulnerable highway user.--A
- 20 person who violates this section and causes the serious bodily
- 21 injury of a vulnerable highway user as a result of the violation
- 22 commits a misdemeanor of the second degree and shall, upon
- 23 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$5,000.
- 24 (e) Bodily injury to a vulnerable highway user. -- A person
- 25 who violates this section and causes the bodily injury of a
- 26 vulnerable highway user as a result of the violation commits a
- 27 <u>misdemeanor of the third degree and shall, upon conviction, be</u>
- 28 sentenced to pay a fine of not more that \$1,000.
- 29 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
