## AN ACT

Amending the act of September 24, 1968 (P.L.1040, No.318), entitled "An act providing for the protection of the safety, 2 health and welfare of the people, property and public roads and highways of the Commonwealth from conditions on coal 3 4 refuse disposal areas, or parts thereof, which fail to comply 5 with the established rules, regulations or quality standards 7 adopted to avoid air or water pollution or to protect water supplies, and from the danger of slipping, sliding or burning 8 of coal refuse disposal areas, or parts thereof, sometimes 9 caused by the storage of coal refuse; prescribing for and 10 regulating the operation of coal refuse disposal areas, and 11 parts thereof; prescribing the powers of the Department of 12 Environmental Resources with respect thereto; providing for the power to enjoin the operation of coal refuse disposal 13 14 areas, or parts thereof, which contain certain conditions; 15 providing for civil and criminal penalties; authorizing the 16 acquisition by condemnation of certain land areas in certain 17 cases; establishing a permit system, authorizing the adoption 18 of rules and regulations, establishing minimum standards; 19 20 requiring bonds and for the maintenance of primary jurisdiction over surface coal mining in Pennsylvania; 21 providing incentives for coal refuse disposal activities on 22 previously affected areas; and providing for coal refuse 23 disposal research," further providing for designating areas 24 unsuitable for coal refuse disposal. 25

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 27 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6.1(i) of the act of September 24, 1968
- 2 (P.L.1040, No.318), known as the Coal Refuse Disposal Control
- 3 Act, is amended AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED BY ADDING A

- 5 Section 6.1. Designating Areas Unsuitable for Coal Refuse
- Disposal.--\* \* \* 6
- 7 (i) All new coal refuse disposal areas shall include a
- 8 system to prevent adverse impacts to surface and ground water
- 9 and to prevent precipitation from contacting the coal refuse AND <--
- SHALL ALLOW FOR REVEGETATION AND THE PREVENTION OF EROSION. The 10
- system for preventing precipitation from contacting the coal 11
- refuse shall be installed, as phases of the coal refuse disposal <--12
- 13 area reach capacity, as specified in the permit, when the
- operator temporarily ceases operation of the coal refuse-14
- disposal area [for a period in excess of ninety days unless the 15
- department, for reasons of a labor strike or business necessity, 16
- 17 approves a longer period that shall not exceed one year] or when
- 18 the operator permanently ceases operation of the coal refuse-
- 19 disposal area. The system shall allow for revegetation and the
- prevention of erosion. For the purposes of this act and the [,]: <--20
- 21 (1) AS PHASES OF THE COAL REFUSE DISPOSAL AREA REACH
- 22 CAPACITY[,];
- 23 (2) AS SPECIFIED IN THE PERMIT[,];
- (3) WHEN THE OPERATOR TEMPORARILY CEASES OPERATION OF THE 24
- COAL REFUSE DISPOSAL AREA FOR A PERIOD IN EXCESS OF NINETY DAYS 25
- UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT[, FOR REASONS OF A LABOR STRIKE OR 26
- 27 BUSINESS NECESSITY, ] APPROVES [A] AN OPERATOR'S REQUEST FOR A
- LONGER PERIOD [THAT SHALL NOT EXCEED ONE YEAR]; OR 28
- 29 (4) WHEN THE OPERATOR PERMANENTLY CEASES OPERATION OF THE
- 30 COAL REFUSE DISPOSAL AREA. [THE SYSTEM SHALL ALLOW FOR

- 1 REVEGETATION AND THE PREVENTION OF EROSION.]
- 2 (J) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ACT AND THE policies, rules and
- 3 regulations and standards adopted pursuant to this act, the
- 4 requirements pertaining to temporary cessation of coal refuse
- 5 <u>disposal areas shall be in conformance with regulations and</u>
- 6 standards adopted by the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation
- 7 and Enforcement pursuant to Federal law, namely the Surface
- 8 Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977. HOWEVER, THE <--
- 9 DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE
- 10 CONNECTION OF COAL REFUSE OR RELATED MATERIAL TO THE COAL REFUSE
- 11 DISPOSAL AREA.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
