## A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in declaration of rights, providing for membership in State Employees' Retirement System and Public 3 School Employees' Retirement System. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby resolves as follows: 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of 7 8 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI: 9 That Article I be amended by adding a section to read: § 29. Membership in State Employees' Retirement System and 10 11 <u>Public School Employees' Retirement System.</u> 12 No individual hired on or after the second January 1 13 following adoption of this section may become a member of the 14 State Employees' Retirement System or the Public School 15 Employees' Retirement System unless the individual had credited 16 State service prior to that date. 17 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 18 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the

Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to

- 6 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 7 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 8 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 9 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 10 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 11 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 12 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 13 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 14 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 15 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 16 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 17 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 18 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 19 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 20 passed by the General Assembly.
