12	Section 611. Membership of Associations; Expenses of
13	MembersThe township commissioners, newly elected township
14	commissioners prior to officially taking office and other
15	officers of the township designated by the township
16	commissioners shall attend such conventions, conferences,
17	institutes or schools whenever possible. Each township officer
18	attending such convention, conference, institute or school shall
19	receive a certificate, signed by the presiding officer and
20	secretary or acting secretary of the association, attesting his

presence at the convention, conference, institute, or school. 1 Such certificate shall entitle him to collect from the township 2 3 treasurer expenses which shall be limited to the registration fee, mileage for use of personal vehicle or reimbursement of 4 actual transportation expense going to and returning from such 5 meeting plus all other actual expenses that the township 6 7 commissioners may have agreed to pay. Every delegate attending 8 the annual meeting shall submit to the township commissioners an itemized account of expenses incurred thereat. The township 9 10 commissioners may authorize township employes to be compensated 11 at their regular employe rate during their attendance at the 12 annual meeting. The board of township commissioners may 13 authorize a commissioner who is not employed by the township to 14 receive total or partial reimbursement for lost wages or salary while attending the annual meeting provided that sufficient 15 16 documentation of such wages or salary is presented to the board of township commissioners to justify the reimbursement. The 17 18 expenses of holding any such convention shall be paid pro rata 19 by the townships joining therein.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
