AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against the family,
3 providing for the offense of unregulated transfer of custody
4 of a child.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 4307. Unregulated transfer of custody of a child.

10 (a) General rule.--Except as provided in this section, a
11 person commits a misdemeanor of the second degree if the person:

12 (1) knowingly conducts an unregulated custody transfer
13 of an adopted A child; or <--

14 (2) facilitates or participates in an unregulated
15 custody transfer by recruiting, enticing, soliciting,
16 harboring, transporting, providing, obtaining or maintaining
17 an adopted A child if the person knows or recklessly <--
18 disregards the fact that the adopted child will be subject to <--

1 an unregulated custody transfer.

2 (b) Nonapplicability.--This section does not apply to:

3 (1) placement of a child in accordance with the
4 requirements of Article VII(d) of the act of June 13, 1967
5 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code;

6 (2) activity undertaken in conjunction with or under the
7 supervision of a public or private entity that provides
8 adoption services and is licensed, supervised or regulated by
9 the Department of Human Services; or

10 (3) placement of a child with an adult who has a
11 significant, positive relationship with the child or the
12 child's family and with whom the child is known or reasonably
13 believed to be safe, if:

14 (i) the placement is for a designated period of time
15 or for the duration of a specified event; and

16 (ii) the placement is due to a vacation, an
17 educational function or activity or the incarceration,
18 military service, medical treatment or temporary
19 incapacity of the parent or guardian of the child.

20 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
21 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
22 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

23 "Adopted child." "CHILD." An individual who is under 18 <--
24 years of age and is the subject of an adoption decree that is <--
25 valid under the laws of this Commonwealth or another state or
26 foreign or international law.

27 "Unregulated custody transfer." A transaction by an adoptive <--
28 A parent or other individual having legal custody of an adopted <--
29 A child, undertaken without court approval and with the intent <--
30 to abandon or permanently avoid parental responsibility for the

1 child.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
