AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in purchase of surplus Federal property, providing
- for approval and reports.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 62 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 4103. Approval and reports.
- 9 (a) Resolution. -- An application for enrollment of a law
- 10 enforcement agency, which is working on behalf of a local
- 11 government unit, in a program established by the United States
- 12 Department of Defense under 10 U.S.C. § 2576a (relating to
- 13 excess personal property: sale or donation for law enforcement
- 14 <u>activities</u>) must be approved by a resolution adopted by a
- 15 majority of the full membership of the governing body of the
- 16 <u>local government unit prior to the transmittal of the</u>
- 17 application. The resolution must state that a public hearing was
- 18 conducted on the resolution before adoption.

- 1 (b) Report by law enforcement agency. -- A law enforcement
- 2 agency working on behalf of a local government unit shall
- 3 provide an annual report to the governing body of the local
- 4 government unit specifying all the equipment secured through
- 5 <u>subsection</u> (a) that remains in the possession of the law
- 6 <u>enforcement agency and whether that equipment has been deployed</u>
- 7 <u>during the previous 12 months.</u>
- 8 (c) Report by Pennsylvania State Police. -- The Pennsylvania
- 9 State Police shall provide an annual report to the Governor
- 10 specifying all the equipment secured through a program
- 11 <u>established by the United States Department of Defense under 10</u>
- 12 U.S.C. § 2576a and whether that equipment has been deployed
- 13 <u>during the previous 12 months.</u>
- 14 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 15 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 16 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Local government unit." A county, city, borough,
- 18 <u>incorporated town, township, school district, vocational school</u>
- 19 district or home rule municipality.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
