AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State 2 government; providing for cancer control, prevention and 3 research, for ambulatory surgical center data collection, for 4 the Joint Underwriting Association, for entertainment 5 business financial management firms, for private dam 6 financial assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; 7 providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and 8 lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the 9 Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other 10 money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or 11 any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 12 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 13 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 14 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims 15 against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 16 17 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 18 19 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 20 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 21 22 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 25 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 27 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 29 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 30 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 31 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 32 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 33

5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known
8	as The Fiscal Code, is amended by adding a section to read:
9	Section 1798.4-E. Commonwealth use of land for State
10	correctional institutions.
11	(a) ScopeThis section applies to the following:
12	(1) Real property acquired for State correctional
13	institutions by the Commonwealth.
14	(2) Tax-exempt real property acquired by the
15	Commonwealth for the purpose of State correctional
16	<u>institutions.</u>
17	(3) Real property:
18	(i) which is acquired for the purpose of State
19	correctional institutions; and
20	(ii) upon which there is an imposed tax payable by
21	the Commonwealth.
22	(b) Charge
23	(1) For land owned by the Department of Corrections or
24	the Department of General Services on behalf of the
25	Commonwealth for State correctional institutions, real
26	property under subsection (a) shall be subject to an annual
27	<u>charge of:</u>
28	(i) \$4 per acre for the benefit of each county where
29	the real property is located;
30	(ii) \$12 per acre for the benefit of the schools in
31	each school district where the real property is located;

1	(iii) \$4 per acre for the benefit of the city,
2	township or borough where the real property is located.
3	(2) The charge under paragraph (1) shall be payable by
4	the Commonwealth before September 2.
5	(c) CertificationUpon application of the governing body
6	or fiscal officer of the political subdivision, the Secretary of
7	Corrections shall certify to the respective political
8	subdivisions where real property under subsection (a) is located
9	and to the State Treasurer:
10	(1) the number of acres owned by the Commonwealth in the
11	political subdivision; and
12	(2) the charge against the real property.
13	(d) PaymentThe State Treasurer shall pay to political
14	subdivisions under subsection (c) the amount due under
15	subsection (b) upon:
16	(1) requisition of the Secretary of Corrections; and
17	(2) application by the appropriate governing body or
18	fiscal officer.
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
