## AN ACT

- Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 15552, on that
- portion of U.S. Route 219 over Elk Creek, Ridgway Borough, 2 3
  - Elk County, as the Elk County Vietnam Veterans Memorial
- 4 Bridge.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Elk County Vietnam Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- 8 Designation .-- The bridge located on U.S. Route 219 over
- the Elk Creek, Ridgway Borough, Elk County, is designated as the
- 10 Elk County Vietnam Veterans Memorial Bridge in recognition of
- the men and women who bravely served in the Vietnam Conflict and 11
- 12 the following individuals who sacrificed their lives for their
- 13 country:

- 2 (6) John Ellsworth Showers, Jr., United States Army.

- 4 (8) Paul Eugene Yonkie, United States Air Force.
- 5 (b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 6 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 7 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 8 Section 2. Effective date.
- 9 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
