The definition of "public water system" in 8 section 3 of the act of May 1, 1984 (P.L.206, No.43), known as 10 the Pennsylvania Safe Drinking Water Act, is amended to read: 11 Section 3. Definitions. - 16 "Public water system." As follows:
- 17 (1) A system for the provision to the public of water
- 18 for human consumption which has at least 15 service

1	connections or regularly serves an average of at least 25
2	individuals daily at least 60 days out of the year. The term
3	includes:
4	[(1)] Any collection, treatment, storage and
5	distribution facilities under control of the operator of
6	such system and used in connection with such system.
7	[(2)] <u>(ii)</u> Any collection or pretreatment storage
8	facilities not under such control which are used in
9	connection with such a system.
10	[(3)] <u>(iii)</u> A system which provides water for
11	[bottling or] bulk hauling for human consumption[.]
12	including bulk haulers of water to establishments that
13	bottle water for human consumption.
14	(iv) A water source used to produce bottled water
15	for human consumption manufactured at a facility located
16	in this Commonwealth, regardless of the size of the
17	bottled water container.
18	(2) The term does not include a food establishment that
19	bottles water for human consumption and is registered under 3
20	Pa.C.S. § 5734 (relating to registration of food
21	establishments), regardless of the size of the bottled water
