Instructional Certificate Grade Spans and 13 14 Age Levels and Duties of Department. -- (a) The following shall apply to special education certificates: 15 16 (1) Notwithstanding 22 Pa. Code \$ 49.85 (relating to <--17 limitations), the grade span and age levels for special 18 education certificates issued after December 31, [2021] 2022, 19 shall be prekindergarten through grade twelve or up to twenty-20 one (21) years of age.
