AN ACT

1 Amending Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed))
2 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for
3 preliminary provisions and for administration.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 63 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding parts to read:

4 § 2101. Definitions.

5 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
6 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
7 context clearly indicates otherwise:

8 "Cultural competence." The ability to understand,
9 communicate with and effectively interact with people of
10 different races, ethnicities and cultures relating to health and
11 the delivery of health care.

12 "Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.

13 "Health-related State board." As follows:

14 (1) Any of the following:

15 (i) The State Board of Chiropractic.

16 (ii) The State Board of Dentistry.

17 (iii) The State Board of Massage Therapy.

18 (iv) The State Board of Medicine.

19 (v) The State Board of Nursing.

20 (vi) The State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home
21 Administrators.

22 (vii) The State Board of Occupational Therapy,
23 Education and Licensure.

24 (viii) The State Board of Optometry.

25 (ix) The State Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

26 (x) The State Board of Pharmacy.

27 (xi) The State Board of Physical Therapy.

28 (xii) The State Board of Podiatry.

29 (xiii) The State Board of Psychology.

30 (xiv) The State Board of Examiners in Speech-

1 Language Pathology and Audiology.

2 (xv) The State Board of Social Workers, Marriage and
3 Family Therapists and Professional Counselors.

4 (2) The term does not include the State Board of
5 Veterinary Medicine.

6 "Implicit bias." A belief or set of associations about a
7 group or an individual based upon physical characteristics,
8 race, ethnicity, gender, age, religious creed or sexual
9 orientation, which can result in the inaccurate attribution of
10 particular qualities to the group or individual.

11 § 2102. Continuing education.

12 (a) Requirement.--The department shall require each person
13 applying for a license or certification issued by a health-
14 related State board to complete training regarding implicit bias
15 and cultural competence in accordance with the continuing
16 education requirements of the health-related State board. At a
17 minimum, the training must include the understanding of implicit
18 bias, including, but not limited to, practical techniques to
19 mitigate implicit bias and improve cultural competence.

20 (b) Documentation.--Each person applying for a license or
21 certification issued by a health-related State board shall
22 submit documentation acceptable to the health-related State
23 board of the completion of the training under subsection (a).

24 § 2103. Regulations.

25 The department shall promulgate regulations regarding the
26 following:

27 (1) The competencies that must be achieved through the
28 curriculum and delivery of the training specified under
29 section 2102(a) (relating to continuing education).

30 (2) The minimum number of credit hours necessary for the

1 training specified under section 2102(a).

2 Section 2. This act shall apply to a license or
3 certification issued by a health-related State board on or after
4 the date of the promulgation of the regulations under 63 Pa.C.S.
5 § 2103.

6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
