AN ACT

- 1 Providing for restrictions on the use of small plastic bottles 2 by lodging establishments.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Single Use
- 7 Plastic Bottle Prevention Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Lodging establishment." A hotel, motel, inn, resort,
- 13 guesthouse, hostel, bed and breakfast establishment or building
- 14 that is held out by any means as being available to provide
- 15 overnight lodging for consideration to individuals seeking
- 16 temporary accommodation.
- 17 "Personal care product." A product intended to be used on or

- 1 applied to the human body in a shower or bath, including any of
- 2 the following:
- 3 (1) Shampoo.
- 4 (2) Hair conditioner.
- 5 (3) Bath soap.
- 6 "Plastic." Any synthetic material made from organic
- 7 polymers, such as polyethylene, polyvinyl chloride or nylon,
- 8 that can be molded into a shape while soft and then set into a
- 9 rigid or slightly elastic form.
- "Sleeping room accommodation." A space in a lodging
- 11 establishment set aside for use and occupancy by individuals
- 12 having at least one bed or other sleeping accommodation in a
- 13 room or group of rooms.
- "Small plastic bottle." A plastic bottle or other container
- 15 with less than a six-ounce capacity that is intended to be
- 16 nonreusable by the end user.
- 17 Section 3. Restrictions on use of small plastic bottles.
- 18 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided under subsection (b),
- 19 commencing January 1, 2024, for lodging establishments with more
- 20 than 50 sleeping room accommodations, and January 1, 2025, for
- 21 lodging establishments with 50 sleeping room accommodations or
- 22 less, a lodging establishment may not provide a small plastic
- 23 bottle containing a personal care product in a sleeping room
- 24 accommodation or in a bathroom shared by guests or the public.
- 25 (b) Exception.--A lodging establishment may provide personal
- 26 care products in small plastic bottles to a person at no cost,
- 27 upon request, at a place other than a sleeping room
- 28 accommodation or a bathroom shared by guests or the public.
- 29 (c) Bulk dispensers. -- A lodging establishment may provide
- 30 personal care items in bulk dispensers in a sleeping room

- 1 accommodation or in a bathroom shared by guests or the public.
- 2 Section 4. Penalties.
- 3 A lodging establishment that violates any provision of this
- 4 act shall be subject to a civil penalty of \$500 for the first
- 5 violation and \$2,000 for each subsequent violation.
- 6 Section 5. Ordinances.
- 7 A municipality may enact an ordinance relating to lodging
- 8 establishments providing personal care products in small plastic
- 9 bottles if the ordinance is at least as stringent as and not in
- 10 conflict with this act.
- 11 Section 6. Effective date.
- 12 This act shall take effect immediately.
