## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; in safe schools, establishing the School Student Mental Health Assistance Augmentation Account and providing for deposit of court costs and filing fees into 8 the account; and making an inconsistent repeal. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 102 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, 13 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by 14 adding definitions to read: Section 102. Definitions .-- When used in this act the 15 following words and phrases shall have the following meanings: 16 17 18 "School psychologist." An individual who holds a valid 19 certificate for school psychologist issued by the Department of Education which qualifies the individual to be employed by and 20

working within a school entity.

- 1 <u>"School social worker."</u> An individual who:
- 2 (1) holds an educational specialist certificate for school
- 3 social workers issued by the Department of Education;
- 4 (2) meets the exception for a school social worker as
- 5 provided under section 20(a.1) of the act of July 9, 1987
- 6 (P.L.220, No.39), known as the "Social Workers, Marriage and
- 7 Family Therapists and Professional Counselors Act"; or
- 8 (3) holds either a social worker license issued by the
- 9 Department of State or another certificate issued by the
- 10 <u>Department of Education prior to the Department of Education's</u>
- 11 development of an educational specialist certificate for school
- 12 social workers.

- 14 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 15 <u>Section 1302.2-A. School Student Mental Health Assistance</u>
- 16 Augmentation Account. -- (a) The School Student Mental Health
- 17 Assistance Augmentation Account is established as a restricted
- 18 receipts account within the General Fund.
- 19 (b) Notwithstanding 42 Pa.C.S. § 3733(a.1)(2)(iii) (relating
- 20 to deposits into account), for the fiscal year 2020-2021 and
- 21 each fiscal year thereafter, \$8 of each additional fee imposed
- 22 under 42 Pa.C.S. § 3733(a.1)(1) shall be deposited into the
- 23 account and \$2 of each additional fee shall be deposited into
- 24 the Access to Justice Account.
- 25 (c) Money deposited into the account is appropriated on a
- 26 continuing basis to the Department of Education for distribution
- 27 <u>under subsection (d).</u>
- 28 (d) All money deposited into the account shall be used for
- 29 the purpose of providing grants to school entities to support
- 30 <u>school-linked mental health services. The Department of</u>

- 1 Education shall, upon written application and subsequent
- 2 approval, grant money from the account to a school entity.
- 3 Allowable grant activities and related expenses include:
- 4 (1) Employing and retaining one of the following mental
- 5 <u>health professionals:</u>
- 6 (i) A school counselor.
- 7 (ii) A school psychologist.
- 8 (iii) A school social worker.
- 9 (2) Providing mental health services and transportation for
- 10 <u>students receiving school-linked mental health services.</u>
- 11 (e) The Department of Education shall establish grant
- 12 <u>application review procedures and shall prioritize grant funding</u>
- 13 for activities and related expenses under subsection (d) (1).
- 14 (f) Grant money allocated through the account shall be used
- 15 to supplement and not supplant existing school entity spending
- 16 <u>on mental health professionals.</u>
- 17 (q) The Department of Education shall promulgate rules and
- 18 regulations as necessary to administer this section.
- (h) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 20 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 21 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 22 "Account." The School Student Mental Health Assistance
- 23 Augmentation Account established under subsection (a).
- 24 "School counselor." An individual who holds a valid
- 25 <u>certificate for Elementary and Secondary School Counselor issued</u>
- 26 by the Department of Education which qualifies the individual to
- 27 be employed by and working within a school entity.
- 28 "School entity." A school district, charter school, regional
- 29 charter school, cyber charter school, an intermediate unit or
- 30 area vocational-technical school operating within this

- 1 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 2 Section 3. The provisions of 42 Pa.C.S. § 3733(a.1)(2)(iii)
- 3 are repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the addition
- 4 of section 1302.2-A of the act.
- 5 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, or
- 6 immediately, whichever is later.
