- 3 The COVID-19 Crisis Fire Company and Emergency Medical
- 4 <u>Services Grant Program is established and shall be administered</u>
- 5 by the agency. Grants provided under the program shall be used
- 6 by fire companies and EMS companies to provide services during
- 7 the novel coronavirus pandemic as identified in the Governor's
- 8 Proclamation of Disaster Emergency issued on March 6, 2020.
- 9 § 7823.2. Publication and notice.
- 10 The agency shall transmit notice of the COVID-19 Crisis Fire
- 11 Company and Emergency Medical Services Grant Program

- 16 (a) Authorization. -- The agency shall make a grant award from
- 17 the COVID-19 Crisis Fire Company and Emergency Medical Services
- 18 Grant Program to:
- 19 <u>(1) Each eliqible fire company that received a grant</u>
- award in fiscal year 2019-2020 under section 7813 (relating
- 21 to award of grants) for the purposes under section 7813(a)

- 23 (2) Each eligible EMS company that received a grant
- award in fiscal year 2019-2020 under section 7823 (relating

- 26 (b) Amount of award. -- The amount of the grant award under

- 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of
- 7 \$30,000,000 shall be transferred from the Volunteer Companies
- 8 Loan Fund to the agency for purposes of making grants under
- 9 Subchapter C.1 (relating to COVID-19 Crisis Fire Company and
- 10 Emergency Medical Services Grant Program). The following shall

- 25 The authority of the agency to award grants under Subchapter

- 27 Medical Services Grant Program) shall expire 180 days after the
