AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 1 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 6 7 8 9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," in voting by qualified absentee electors, further 11 providing for official absentee voters ballots; and, in 12 voting by qualified mail-in electors, further providing for 13 official mail-in elector ballots. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 hereby enacts as follows: 17 Section 1. Sections 1303(e) and 1303-D(e) of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election 18 Code, amended March 27, 2020 (P.L. , No.12), are amended to 19 20 read: 21 Section 1303. Official Absentee Voters Ballots. --* * * 22 The official absentee voter ballot shall state that an 23 elector who receives an absentee ballot pursuant to section 1301

- 1 and whose voted ballot is not timely received by the commission
- 2 and who, on election day, is capable of voting at the
- 3 appropriate polling place may only vote on election day by
- 4 provisional ballot unless the elector brings the elector's
- 5 absentee ballot to the elector's polling place, remits the
- 6 ballot and the envelope containing the declaration of the
- 7 elector to the judge of elections to be spoiled and signs a
- 8 statement subject to the penalties under 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904
- 9 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities) to the same
- 10 effect. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall prescribe the
- 11 text and the manner by which the notice under this subsection
- 12 <u>shall be printed on a ballot.</u>
- 13 Section 1303-D. Official mail-in elector ballots.
- 14 * * *
- 15 (e) Notice. -- The official mail-in voter ballot shall state
- 16 that a voter who receives a mail-in ballot under section 1301-D
- 17 and whose voted mail-in ballot is not timely received may only
- 18 vote on election day by provisional ballot unless the elector
- 19 brings the elector's mail-in ballot to the elector's polling
- 20 place, remits the ballot and the envelope containing the
- 21 declaration of the elector to the judge of elections to be
- 22 spoiled and signs a statement subject to the penalties of 18
- 23 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to
- 24 authorities) to the same effect. The Secretary of the
- 25 Commonwealth shall prescribe the text and the manner by which
- 26 the notice under this subsection shall be printed on a ballot.
- 27 Section 2. The amendment of sections 1303(e) and 1303-D(e)
- 28 of the act shall apply to elections held on or after November 3,
- 29 2020.
- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
