## AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting termination of cable and Internet service during a disaster emergency.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Emergency
- 7 Cable and Internet Service Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Cable service provider." A person that provides cable
- 13 television services, video programming services or any other
- 14 distribution of television or video services.
- "Disaster emergency." A disaster emergency declared by the
- 16 Governor under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general
- 17 authority of Governor).
- "Internet service provider." A person that furnishes a

- 1 service that enables users to access content, information, e-
- 2 mail or other services offered over the Internet and access to
- 3 proprietary content, information and other services.
- 4 Section 3. Prohibition.
- 5 (a) Prohibition. -- Cable service providers and Internet
- 6 service providers may not terminate service in this Commonwealth
- 7 during the pendency of a disaster emergency.
- 8 (b) Payment. -- The prohibition under subsection (a) shall not
- 9 be construed to relieve the recipient of cable or internet
- 10 service of the obligation to pay for those services once a
- 11 disaster emergency is terminated or expires under 35 Pa.C.S.
- 12 section 7301(c) (relating to general authority of Governor).
- 13 Section 4. Effective date.
- 14 This act shall take effect immediately.
