AN ACT

- 1 Providing for temporary services to aging-out individuals 2 through county agencies; and imposing duties on county
- agencies and the Department of Human Services.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Pandemic
- 8 Assistance for Transition-age Foster Youth Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Aging-out individual." An individual who:
- 14 (1) Was adjudicated a dependent child prior to March 1,
- 15 2020, and attained 18 years of age.
- 16 (2) Was authorized by a court prior to March 1, 2020, to
- 17 remain a dependent child after attaining 18 years of age.
- 18 (3) Either:

- 1 (i) as of the effective date of this section, is no
- 2 longer a dependent child as a result of having attained
- 3 21 years of age; or
- 4 (ii) on or after the effective date of this section,
- 5 attains 21 years of age and no longer meets the
- 6 definition of a dependent child under 42 Pa.C.S. Ch. 63
- 7 (relating to juvenile matters).
- 8 "County agency." As defined in 23 Pa.C.S. § 6303 (relating
- 9 to definitions).
- 10 "Department." The Department of Human Services of the
- 11 Commonwealth.
- 12 Section 3. Scope of temporary services.
- 13 (a) Right to make election. -- An aging-out individual may
- 14 elect to receive housing, case management and other support
- 15 services through a county agency.
- 16 (b) Duties of county agency. --
- 17 (1) The county agency shall provide written and verbal
- 18 notice to aging-out individuals of the temporary services
- available under this act in a manner that is readily
- 20 understandable and youth-friendly. The county agency shall
- 21 document in each case file when and how notice was given and
- 22 whether services were accepted.
- 23 (2) If an aging-out individual elects to receive
- 24 services under subsection (a), the county agency shall
- 25 provide all appropriate support services as if the aging-out
- 26 individual remained as a dependent child under the
- jurisdiction of the court.
- 28 (3) The county agency shall develop a transition plan
- 29 with an eligible aging-out individual prior to the
- 30 termination of temporary services.

- 1 (4) On the effective date of this section and on a
- 2 monthly basis thereafter, the county agency shall provide the
- department with a list of individuals who are eligible for
- 4 temporary services under this act. The list shall specify
- 5 which individuals continue to receive services, which
- 6 individuals declined to receive services and whether a
- 7 finalized transition plan is or was in place for each
- 8 individual listed.
- 9 (c) Duties of department.--
- 10 (1) The department shall, from funds appropriated or
- otherwise made available to the department for the purpose,
- award grants to county agencies for complying with the duty
- under subsection (b).
- 14 (2) The department shall publicize, through its publicly
- accessible Internet website and other communication outlets,
- the services available under this act.
- 17 (3) The department shall share the information provided
- by the county agency under subsection (b) (4) with the Office
- 19 of the Child Advocate.
- 20 Section 4. Funding.
- 21 (a) Duty of department. -- Within seven days of the effective
- 22 date of this section, the department, through the Office of
- 23 Budget, shall submit a budget request to the Appropriations
- 24 Committee of the Senate and the Appropriations Committee of the
- 25 House of Representatives that provides an estimate of the amount
- 26 of money needed to satisfy the requirements of this act and the
- 27 source of funding, including any available funding from the
- 28 Federal Government, for the payment of the amount.
- 29 (b) Effect of grant award. -- Notwithstanding any other
- 30 provision of law to the contrary, the amount of a grant received

- 1 by a county agency under this act shall not affect the
- 2 eligibility of, or amount awarded to, the county agency under
- 3 any need-based grant and budget process.
- 4 Section 5. Expiration.
- 5 This act shall expire December 31, 2020.
- 6 Section 6. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect immediately.
