AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," in emergency provisions for 2020 general primary
12 election, providing for required mailing of application for
13 official mail-in ballot.

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
17 as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a
18 section to read:

19 Section 1804.1-B. Required mailing of application for official
20 mail-in ballot.

21 No later than seven days after the effective date of this
22 section, a county board of elections shall mail an application
23 for official mail-in ballot to each qualified elector under

1 section 1301-D who voted in at least one of the last four
2 elections in this Commonwealth.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
