AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of April 9, 1870 (P.L.59, No.38), entitled "A
2 supplement to an act, entitled 'An Act to provide for the
3 reduction of the public debt,' approved the twenty-second
4 April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-six."

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1870 (P.L.59, No.38),
8 entitled "A supplement to an act, entitled 'An Act to provide
9 for the reduction of the public debt,' approved the twenty-
10 second April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-
11 six," is repealed:

12 [A SUPPLEMENT

13 To an act, entitled "An Act to provide for the reduction of the
14 public debt," approved the twenty-second April, Anno Domini
15 one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.

16 Section 1. What manufacturers and mechanics shall be
17 licensed

18 Manufacturers and mechanics, who shall sell goods, wares or
19 merchandise, other than their own manufacture, not exceeding the

1 sum or value of five hundred dollars per annum, shall not be
2 classified or required to pay any annual tax or license fee; but
3 if such sales shall exceed the sum of value of five hundred
4 dollars per annum, as aforesaid, they shall be classified in the
5 same manner, and required to pay the same annual tax as is now
6 required to be paid by dealers in foreign merchandise.]

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
