AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the first, second class A, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; 3 amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws 4 relating thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes by 5 counties, including authorizing imposition of an excise tax 6 7 on the rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and providing for regional renaissance initiatives," 8 in preliminary provisions, further providing for 9 applicability; and, in district attorney, assistants and 10 11 detectives, providing for term limits. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 102(a) of the act of August 9, 1955 15 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, is amended to read: 16 Section 102. Applicability .-- (a) Except incidentally, as in sections 108, 201, 210, 211, 401 [and], 1401 and 1401.1 or as 17 provided in section 1770.12, Article XII-B and Article XXX, this 18 19 act does not apply to counties of the first or second classes. * * * 20 21 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: 22 Section 1401.1. Term Limits. -- (a) Notwithstanding any other
- 23 law or home rule charter provision and subject to subsection

- 1 (b), an individual shall be ineligible to serve as district
- 2 attorney in a county more than:
- 3 (1) two terms to which the district attorney is elected; or
- 4 (2) the conclusion of a term to which the district attorney
- 5 was not elected and two additional terms.
- 6 (b) A district attorney who is serving on the effective date
- 7 of this section may not, after the conclusion of the term:
- 8 (1) be elected to more than one additional term, if the
- 9 district attorney was elected to the term being served on the
- 10 effective date of this section; or
- 11 (2) be elected to more than two terms, if the district
- 12 attorney was not elected to the term being served on the
- 13 <u>effective date of this section.</u>
- (c) This section shall apply to all counties.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
