AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in changes in records, further providing for death
- of registrant.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1505(a) of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1505. Death of registrant.
- 9 (a) [Department of Health] Registrars. -- A commission shall
- 10 cancel the registration of a registered elector reported dead by
- 11 [the Department of Health. The Department of Health shall,
- 12 within 60 days of receiving notice of the death of an individual
- 13 18 years of age or older, send the name and address of residence
- 14 of that individual to] a local registrar or the State Registrar
- 15 of Vital Statistics. Within two business days after a local
- 16 registrar or the State Registrar of Vital Statics receives a
- 17 death certificate under section 501 of the act of June 29, 1953

- 1 (P.L.304, No.66), known as the Vital Statistics Law of 1953, of
- 2 <u>an individual 18 years of age or older, the local registrar or</u>
- 3 State Registrar of Vital Statics shall forward the death
- 4 <u>certificate to</u> a commission in a manner and on a form prescribed
- 5 by the department. The commission shall promptly update
- 6 information contained in its registration records.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
