AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," IN PUPILS AND ATTENDANCE, PROVIDING FOR AGE LIMIT EXTENSION DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC OF 2020; 5 6 AND, in terms and courses of study, providing for option year 7 of education due to COVID-19. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding $\frac{1}{2}$ section SECTIONS to read: 13 <--SECTION 1301.1. AGE LIMIT EXTENSION DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC <--14 15 OF 2020. -- NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 1301, EVERY STUDENT WHO WAS 16 TWENTY (20) OR TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS OF AGE BEFORE THE

PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR ON

- 1 MARCH 6, 2020, PUBLISHED AT 50 PA.B. 1644 (MARCH 21, 2020), AND
- 2 ANY RENEWAL OF THE STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY, AND WHO WAS
- 3 ENROLLED IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THIS COMMONWEALTH, IN
- 4 ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 1301, DURING THE PROCLAMATION OF
- 5 DISASTER EMERGENCY, OR ANY RENEWAL OF THE STATE OF DISASTER
- 6 EMERGENCY, SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A TWELVE-MONTH EXTENSION OF
- 7 ELIGIBILITY UNDER SECTION 1301 FREE OF CHARGE.
- 8 <u>Section 1501.11 1501.10. Option Year of Education Due to</u>
- 9 COVID-19.--(a) The welfare of this Commonwealth requires that
- 10 the present generation of school age children be provided ample
- 11 opportunity to develop to their fullest intellectual
- 12 <u>capacities. It is the intent of the General Assembly to ensure</u>
- 13 that the present generation of school age children do not lose
- 14 <u>educational opportunities due to the proclamation of disaster</u>
- 15 <u>emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at</u>
- 16 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020).
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for the
- 18 2021-2022 school year, a parent may elect to have a child in a
- 19 school entity repeat a grade level to make up for any lost
- 20 educational opportunities during the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021
- 21 school years regardless of whether the child met the
- 22 requirements to be promoted to the next grade level. The
- 23 parental election under this subsection shall include
- 24 participation in all academic or extracurricular activities.
- 25 (c) A school entity shall create a process for a parent to
- 26 make the election under subsection (b) and post the process on
- 27 its publicly accessible Internet website.
- 28 <u>(d) As used in this section, the term "school entity" shall</u>
- 29 mean a school district, intermediate unit, area career and
- 30 <u>technical school</u>, <u>charter school</u>, <u>cyber charter school</u>, <u>regional</u>

- 1 charter school or nonpublic school entity.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
