AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled "An act relating to the finances of the State government; 2 providing for cancer control, prevention and research, for 3 ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint 4 Underwriting Association, for entertainment business 5 financial management firms, for private dam financial 6 7 assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, 8 bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the 9 collection and recovery of fees and other money or property 10 11 due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, including escheated property and the proceeds of its sale, 12 the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds 13 and securities belonging to or in the possession of the 14 Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the 15 Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and appeals to the 16 courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the 17 Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and 18 all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 19 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 20 21 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 22 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of 23 section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 25 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 27 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 29 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 30 31 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 32 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or 33 other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 34 35 Commonwealth, "in emergency COVID-19 response, further

- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 160-C(a) of the act of April 9, 1929
- 6 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is amended by
- 7 adding a paragraph to read:
- 8 Section 160-C. Use of money.
- 9 (a) Uses.--The following shall apply:
- 10 * * *
- 11 (10.1) Subject to paragraph (11), from money
- 12 <u>appropriated for COVID Relief Child-Care Services</u>,
- \$100,000,000 shall be allocated for child care services. The
- 14 <u>Department of Human Services shall develop criteria for</u>
- distribution of the appropriation to eliqible child care
- 16 providers using: Child Care Works program data and
- objectives; the study issued on the economic impacts of child
- 18 care closures during the proclamation of disaster emergency
- issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020; viability of
- 20 providers due to the varying business models, market factors,
- impacts of the business closure orders, child care deserts or
- 22 other individual provider circumstances not accounted for in
- 23 the study; and any other factors deemed relevant by the
- 24 <u>Department of Human Services.</u>
- 25 * * *
- Section 2. The sum of \$100,000,000, or as much thereof as
- 27 may be necessary, of Federal money is appropriated from the
- 28 COVID-19 Response Restricted Account for COVID Relief to the
- 29 Department of Human Services for the purpose of making payments
- 30 for child care services under section 160-C(a)(10.1) of the act.
- 31 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
