## A RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to provide for priority bills. 3 RESOLVED, That the Rules of the House of Representatives be amended by adding a rule to read: 4 5 RULE 21 (a) Priority Bills 6 7 Upon a bill receiving the co-sponsorship of 20 members of the 8 majority party and 20 members of the minority party, one cosponsor from the majority party and one co-sponsor from the minority party may request in writing to the Chief Clerk that 10 11 the bill be designated as a priority bill. Upon receipt of the 12 request, the Chief Clerk shall designate the bill as a priority 13 bill and shall notify the Speaker, the Majority Leader, the

Minority Leader and the chair and minority chair of the

- 2 A priority bill shall, if in committee, receive a committee
- 3 vote on the motion to report the bill to the Floor, without a
- 4 recommendation to refer the bill to another committee, within
- 5 three legislative days of the bill being designated as a
- 6 priority bill. The chair of the committee may delay the vote on
- 7 the motion to report the bill for up to three additional
- 8 <u>legislative days for the purpose of conducting a public hearing</u>
- 9 on the bill.
- 10 A priority bill in possession of the House shall receive
- 11 first consideration upon receipt from committee, and members
- 12 <u>shall be notified that the priority bill shall be considered on</u>
- 13 <u>second consideration on the earliest permitted legislative day</u>
- 14 pursuant to Rule 21. Upon second consideration, members shall be
- 15 notified that the priority bill will be considered on third
- 16 consideration and final passage at the earliest date permitted
- 17 pursuant to the rules.
